Wildflower Hike 10:00am - 12:00pm

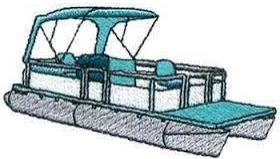
Come join a Ranger for a guided flower hike and learn about some of the wildflowers in the park. Moderate hike. **Meet at the registration office.**
